- Promotion of general XBRL best practices within XBRL-EU
- Reports directly to XBRL-EU Executive Committee
- Activities in line with XBRL International Best Practice Board
- Current activity particularly focused on providing support to ESMA and the ESEF programme
- Perceived need in order to consistent approach and smooth implementation.

- Why ?
- ESMA has a mandate to define the reporting format
- The format imposes obligations that are embodied in EU legislation and described in the Regulatory Technical Standards (RTS)
- But the RTS is mainly concerned with "what" rather than the "how"
- It is also not concerned with other reporting obligations such as those imposed by national and other market regulators.

- Promoting consistent approaches for common issues.
- Providing guidance where there are choices to made.
- Reducing effort and complexity.
- Learning from the experiences of others.
