XBRL Europe has reviewed its membership in 2016 with four categories to be able to accept a type of members (jurisdictions, EU institutions, general entities and individuals) and to cope with a growing demand specifically in the wake of the ESEF project. The European Single Electronic Format (ESEF) is the electronic reporting format in which issuers on EU regulated markets shall prepare their annual financial reports from 1st January 2020.

XBRL Europe has since end 2018 developed an ESEF Hub where all information on ESEF can be found. This XBRL Europe Digital HUB has been highly recognized and praised by all the stakeholders including the Authorities.

## **About XBRL France?**

XBRL France is a not for profit organization, jurisdiction of XBRL International and founding and active member of XBRL Europe.

The objective of XBRL France, as with other XBRL regional organisations like XBRL Europe and jurisdictions around the world, is to promote the use of the XBRL standard for financial reporting.

XBRL France is located at 19 rue Cognacq Jay – Paris 7ème, in the premises of the Institute of Chartered Accountants (Conseil Supérieur de l'Ordre des Experts Comptables). The ACPR Banque de France (The Authority for Banls and Insrances - Formely known as the Banking Commission) which is kindly histing the 23<sup>rd</sup> XBRL Europe days is a very active member of XBRL France, being also its chair represented by Vincent Le Moal-Joubel.

The aim of XBRL France is to help in France, and as necessary in neighbouring countries, the different professions involved in all types of reporting (Banks, Insurance, Financial institutions, Business Register, Stock listed companies, Auditors, etc) to understand the use the XBRL language. To this end, working groups have been constituted and work closely with the ones of XBRL Europe.


## THE WORKING GROUPS

XBRL Europe has set up dedicated Working Groups during which its members gather regularly (by conference calls or face-to-face meetings).

These working groups are currently:

- Bank and Insurance Working Group Contributes to the regulatory reporting processes (COREP, FINREP, Solveny2) for the institutions under supervision of EBA/ECB and EIOPA, to share experiences learned from preparers and liaise with supervisors Co-Chairs: Vincent Le Moal-Joubel (XBRL France) & Thomas Verdin (TESH Advice, XBRL UK & Europe).
- <u>Standard Business Reporting Working Group</u> Identifies and provides guidance on best practices regarding the implementation of SBR – Co-Chairs: Frans Hietbrink (XBRL Netherlands) & Elina Koskentalo (XBRL Finland).
- OAM & BR WG Aims to increase coordination and interoperability for XBRL efforts and taxonomies for European business registers and company information providers Pilot: Krzysztof Jesse (Bundesanzeiger, XBRL Germany).
- ESMA ESEF Working Group Educates about European Single Electronic Format ESEF for publishing the Financial statements for listed companies – Co-Chairs: Bruno Tesnière (XBRL Europe Chair) & Gilles Maguet (Secretary General XBRL Europe).
- <u>ESG Forum</u> Promotes XBRL for Environmental Social and Governmental reporting at European level; aims at understanding the various ESG frameworks and at promoting a convergence and a use of XBRL – Chair: Bas Groenveld (XBRL Netherlands).
- XBRL Europe Sustainable Development Task Force Aims to establish a
  membership drive and to assess other resource opportunities Co chairs: Liv
