



<u>Tasks:</u>

- The OAM is the central source for official and valid company information
- The OAM ensures that company information is available sustainably
- The OAM enables searchability for company information
- The OAM carries out quality checks on the company-index data and thus ensures better data quality

<u>Users:</u>

- Authorities and courts, e.g. to receive a printout and register content from the commercial register
- Companies that want to enter into business relationships with other companies
- Credit rating agencies
- Banks that check companies in cases of insolvencies

OAMs differ in the submission process, such as acceptance and handling of formats

- E.g. in Germany almost all annual financial reports are submitted via the Federal Gazette
- Federal Fazette accepts different formats (xbrl,pdf,office,xml)
- These will be converted into a uniform layout XML standard
- After the validation process, these will be transferred in layout XML to the OAM for archiving and searchability

OAMs differ in the submission process, such as acceptance and handling of formats

e.g. France process:

- The annual financial report is deposited by the issuer to the AMF (Financial Market Supervisory Authority)
- AFRs are transferred to DILA (Legal and administrative information department)
- DILA (French OAM) makes the financial information available on their website

<u>Nearly 28 OAMs differ in the submission process, such as acceptance</u> and handling of formats

- difficult to find !
- difficult to compare !

therefore the idea at european level

to further harmonize transparency requirements

- To facilitate access, analysis, and comparability among authorities, issuers, investors regarding to annual financial reports and thus also to promote cross-border investments in the european economic area
- According Transparency Directive 2013/50/EU, ESMA was mandated to develop regulatory standards for a european uniform electronic reporting format and for a European electronic central access portal
- Regulatory standards for European single electronic format (esef) have been passed. from 01.01.2020, issuers must prepare and submit their annual financial reports in xhtml/esef. ESEF is human-readable and machine-readable

European electronic access point (EEAP)

- A consultation phase on RTS with all stakeholders has taken place
- An extensive cost benefit analysis (CBA) has been undertaken by all stakeholders
- EU Regulation (EU) 2016/1437 was endorsed by the COM
- Some OAMs have taken preparations to provide the requested metadata to the central database
- On 31 July 2017 ESMA informed all OAMs about postponement of the implementation of the EEAP

European single electronic format (ESEF)

- The Transparency Directive-Amendment Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 October 2013 amending Directive 2004/109/EC (Transparency Directive Amendment Directive) stipulates that certain capital market-oriented companies must prepare their annual financial reports in a uniform European format with effect from **1 January 2020**.
- The regulatory technical standards for specifying this electronic reporting format are laid down in Commission Delegate Regulation (EU) 2019/815 of 17.12.2018, which was announced on 29.05.2019 (ESEF Regulation).

current status

- The respective national legal implementation act e.g. in Germany relating to ESEF is still pending
- EEAP is still pausing
- To date, there is no central European access portal

- Central platform and webservice for submission of reports to federal gazette and OAM, not available for deposit
- Only issuers may upload ESEF files
- Accepted formats: ZIP and XHTML only
- No preview
- The submission in ESEF format is only for fiscal years beginning at January 1st 2020
- Manual transformation into uniform representation (layout XML)

- Current various technical validations:
 - Company must confirm the current status of being an issuer
 - Only XHTML and ZIP files allowed
 - MIME-Type must suit the file ending and file contents
 - Filenames and directory names within the ZIP file must comply with some limitations (no special chars, max 128 chars in total length)
 - No active content (JavaScript, VBScript, Flash, ...)
 - Antivirus Check

- Future various technical validations:
 - No IFRAMES
 - All referenced objects in XHTML files must be contained in the ZIP archive
 - All files in the ZIP archive are referenced at least once in an XHTML file
 - For consolidated reports: at least on XHTML file must contain a valid XBRL instance

- Publication of ESEF in the Federal Gazette and/or the OAM
- Download of "original" ESEF (XHTML or ZIP)
- View of the report in a uniform representation
- Embedded ESEF-Viewer
 - No tag-highlighting
 - No rewriting of source code
 - Displaying ESEF content "as is"
