






- From financial year 2020, all annual financial reports shall be prepared in xHTML format
- IFRS Consolidated Financial Statements shall be marked-up with XBRL tags
- 1 document, 2 views: Tags embedded in human readable document via the InlineXBRL technology
- **ESEF Taxonomy** = IFRS Taxonomy incl. limited ESMA customisation
- **Extensions**: only if no existing IFRS tag reflects the intended accounting meaning
- Anchoring: extensions shall be linked to the closest taxonomy element
- Level of tagging: detailed tagging of primary statements (from 2020), block tagging of Notes (from 2022)
- Regulation to be yearly updated on the basis of IFRS taxonomy update







ESEF Reporting Manual update 2020

- ESMA published in July 2020 the update of the ESEF Reporting Manual
- Most significant areas of new/updated guidance:
 - Recommendation on when to early adopt latest IFRS/ESEF Taxonomy version
 - Anchoring of extension domain members and other dimensional constructs
 - Naming conventions for reporting package and extension taxonomy files
- Further updates will be considered on the basis of the input of market participants and on the basis of XBRL and regulatory developments




- ESMA will publish in December 2020 the update of the ESEF Taxonomy files
- Most significant changes compared to the previous version:
 - Incorporates IFRS 2020 (2020-03-16) taxonomy update (with 6 new elements and revised labels)
 - Introduces Data Types Registry 1.1 for the guidanceItemType
 - Includes final LEI taxonomy (REC as of 2020-07-02)
 - Error messages for assertions updated to include error codes indicated in the ESEF Reporting Manual/Conformance Suite

ESEF Conformance Suite update December 2020

- ESMA will publish in December 2020 the update of the ESEF Conformance Suite testing package
- Most significant changes compared to the previous version:
 - Number of test cases increased from 60 to 64 and the number of test scenarios increased from 157 to 192
 - Updates to the infrastructure schemas:
 - <automatable> flag was added to indicate which tests may not fully automatically checked/verified due to their noncomprehensive nature
 - <ignore-error> element was added to indicate that there are potentially additional errors that might be raised by the processors, but should be disregarded as not relevant in the tested scenario
 - User friendly documentation of the suite in MS Word format
