We aim to integrate XBRL with Distributed Ledger Technology/Blockchain to improve statutory reporting, data exchange, and analysis, particularly in sustainability and financial reporting.







Web3.0-WG Vision and

- Establish a strategic brage between statutory reporting frameworks and decentralized ledger (DLT)/blockchain ecosystems to enable trusted, tamperproof disclosures.
- Automate data collection and regulatory reporting using bottom-up, digitally native infrastructure that reduces manual burdens and enhances data quality.
- Launch a dedicated working group to drive the integration of XBRL standards with Web 3.0 technologies, advancing compliance innovation.
- Foster cross-sector collaboration and continuous learning through open forums, pilot projects, and shared technical resources.





Activities

The XBRL Reporting for Web 3.0 Working Group (W3 WG) is responsible for:

1. Integrating XBRL with Distributed Ledger Technology for Enhanced Reporting

- Enhancing Efficiency & Security: Utilize DLT to streamline reporting workflows, ensuring data integrity and reducing administrative burdens.
- Real-Time Data Exchange & Verification: Enable seamless and secure data sharing between corporations, regulatory authorities, and stakeholders.
- Automated Smart Contracts: Develop self-executing compliance mechanisms that enhance transparency in financial statements, sustainability metrics, and economic indicators.



Strategic Positioning for the XBRL Europe's Web 3.0-WG

The Convergence Philosophy

Rather than choosing one Web 3.0 definition, we seek to position XBRL as the **universal business language** that enables interoperability across all Web 3.0 paradigms:

- **Semantic Layer:** XBRL taxonomies that AI systems can understand and reason about
- **Ownership Layer**: Self-sovereign business data standards
- **Transaction Layer:** Smart contract integration for automated reporting
- **Experience Layer**: Immersive business intelligence and stakeholder engagement
